If you have reached your state pension age or are disabled / are aged 16-19, or up to 21 for care leavers and live in Cheshire East you may qualify for a bus pass for a discount code for a senior / disabled person's railcard.

Applications for senior and disabled bus passes can also be made in person at any Cheshire East Council Library (please contact the library to confirm they are open and to book an appointment.
