

Merepark handled 4732 phone calls in January, 4060 in February, and 5223 in March – that's a total of **14015 phone calls!** We had an average queue time of **5 minutes** over these months.

We had a total of 181 missed appointments over January, February and March. This cost the NHS approximately £5200!






