### May: Disability Resources A summary of April's Carers Event

#### Thursday 28th April 2024 Highfield Hall

We are thrilled to share the highlights of our recent Carers Event. This event was a fantastic opportunity for carers in our community to connect, learn, and find support.

This month we were thrilled to have the participation of the Disability Resource Centre (DRC) and the Adult Support Hub (ASH).

ASH had a pop up stall, where carers could come and talk to a representative one to one and recieve specific, personalised advise.

Disability Resource Centre (DRC): A representative from the Disability Resource Centre gave an informative talk about the Personal Independence Payment (PIP) application process. PIP is a benefit for people who need help with daily living activities or getting around because of a long-term illness or disability. The representative provided valuable insights into:

- How to apply for PIP
- The assessment process
- What information and documentation are needed

• Tips for ensuring a successful application The session was well-received, with many carers finding the information extremely helpful. It cleared up many common misconceptions and provided practical advice, empowering carers to better support their loved ones through the application process.

Lunch was provided by The Big Feed and the Health Inequalities Care Coordinators, along with our Senior Social Prescriber.
