Learn about dementia to manage the condition more effectively. Utilise online resources and local libraries. Furthermore, regular schedules for meals, activities, and bedtime can help reduce confusion and anxiety. Remove tripping hazards, install grab rails in bathrooms, and ensure good lighting. Use simple sentences, maintain eye contact, and encourage independence while providing support. And most importantly, ensure you take time for yourself, seek respite care, and connect with support groups.

Dementia Respite Care

Crossroads offers free respite breaks for family carers in Birmingham who look after people with dementia or palliative conditions. Funded by Birmingham and Solihull ICB, these breaks are scheduled weekly for 2 to 3 hours or can include overnight stays to allow carers to recharge. After six weeks, we review your situation to assess any changes and determine further support.
