How can I get help if I know I have a Specific Learning Difficulty?

- •If you declared that you have a SpLD when you applied to the University, you will receive an email about registration. All students with a SpLD should register at the Student Support Unit.
- •You will meet with a dyslexia advisor. If you have a current Educational Psychologist's report, or specialist teacher's report, the dyslexia advisor can arrange support (reasonable adjustments), including exam arrangements, at the University. If you don't have a current report you will receive advice on how to arrange an assessment.
- •You will also be advised about funding for UK students (Disabled Students' Allowance) and funding for International students.
- •The Dyslexia Advisor can also provide information about study support and other support services available at the University.
